**Sub: Denial of the benefit of notional promotion and consequential pensionary benefits in terms of DOP&T OM No. 22011/3/2013-Estt. (D) dated 25.01.2016 by not implementing the DOT's promotion Order No. 2/7/08/STG.II dated 21.10.1998 – Case of Shri Shankar Singh Yadav, Retd JTO (HRMS 197605567), BSNL, Maharashtra Telecom Circle.**

Sir,

We are constrained to draw your kind attention to a case in which a pensioner, who was ordered to be promoted by Department of Telecommunications vide its No. 2/7/08/STG.II dated 21.10.1998 as a TES Group Officer but could not avail the benefit since a CBI case was registered against him, is now running from pillar to post to get justice on his acquittal of the charges by a Court of Special judge on 05.12.2012 after his superannuation on 31.07.2012. Even our representation to Director (HR), BSNL vide our No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2018/09 dated 12.02.2018 has failed to evoke any response.


2. This pensioner, Shri Shankar Singh Yadav Retd JTO, once working in Maharashtra Telecom Circle of BSNL was permanently absorbed in Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited after his acquittal vide DoT No. 27-1/MHTC/G.M.T.NP/172/2014-15 dated 29/05/2015 and even his period of suspension was regularized by DOT vide its No. 9-86/1996-Vig.I dated 4/9/2015.

3. Though, due to the peculiar circumstances, the promotion Order of Shri Shankar Singh Yadav, Retd JTO could not be implemented, but he is eligible to get the benefit of "notional promotion" in terms of Deptt of Personnel & Training (DOP&T) OM No. 22011/3/2013-Estt.(D) dated 25.01.2016 and also other consequential pensionary benefits as stipulated in the same Order. Since in this particular case, Shri Shankar Singh Yadav, Retd JTO was already cleared by the DPC and his promotion Order was also issued, it is now just a matter of implementing the said promotion Order to extend the stipulated benefits as provided in the above referred DOP&T OM dated 25.01.2016.

4. We, therefore, seek your kind personal intervention in this case so that justice is bestowed on Shri Shankar Singh Yadav, Retd JTO by allowing him the benefit of "notional promotion" and other consequential pensionary benefits as stipulated in DOP&T OM No. 22011/3/2013-Estt. (D) dated 25.01.2016.
