Sub: Abnormal delay in issue of Presidential Orders for absorption in BSNL – Cases of the retired SDEs

Sir,

We are constraint to bring to your kind notice that there is inordinate delay in issuing Presidential Orders for absorption in BSNL in respect of the SDEs who are now retired and whose absorption process could not be completed while they were in service. These cases are being sent by BSNL from time to time with all required documents to the Staff Section of DOT. But processing of these cases are mostly delayed.


2. We quote the following two cases urging for your kind intervention:-

- (i) Case of Shri S P Contractor, Retd SDE, Gujarat Circle: His case for issue of Presidential Orders for absorption was originally sent by BSNL vide F.No. BSNL/11/SR/2003(9) dated 08/05/2017 to Director (Staff), DOT. A reminder has also been issued recently. But his P.O. has not been issued till date.
- (ii) Case of Shri R K Tripathi, Retd SDE, Rajasthan Circle: Shri Tripathi has been requesting for issue of his P.O. for more than a year. BSNL has since forwarded his case along with required documents to Under Secretary (STG), DOT vide No. BSNL/11/SR/2003 (Raj)/Part.II dated 10/07/2018. Surprisingly, though a Vigilance Clearance already issued by Vigilance Section of DoT was attached along with the letter of BSNL Corporate Office, the Staff Branch has again sought Vigilance clearance from the same Vigilance Section of DOT. This is only contributing in delaying issue of the Presidential Order.

3. In view of the above, we earnestly request you to kindly intervene in the matter so that the above mentioned cases are immediately cleared for issue of Presidential Orders since their pension and pensionary benefits are still held up for want of P.O.s.
