Sub: Non-implementation of CAT Chennai Order in OA 310/00635/2019 – Refund of Rs.72,200/- to Shri R. Damodaran, Retd. SDE, Coimbatore – Reg.

Sir,

We hereby draw your kind attention to the continued non-implementation of the Hon'ble CAT, Chennai Bench order dated 02.02.2024 in OA 310/00635/2019, directing BSNL to refund Rs.72,200/- to Shri R. Damodaran, Retd SDE, Coimbatore, along with interest at GPF rate in case of delay beyond two months.


2. Despite the Tribunal's clear directions, the refund has not been made even after more than 21 months. Tamil Nadu Circle has also been writing to BSNL Corporate Office, the last communication being on 23.04.2025, seeking instructions for implementation.

3. In response to our letter dated 13.11.2025, BSNL Corporate Office issued a reply vide letter No. BSNLCO-COMN/12(11)/11/2021-PERS-II-Part (9) dated 15.12.2025 (copy enclosed), stating that *"the matter is under examination for taking further course of action."* However, five months have passed since this reply, and there has been no progress or communication thereafter.

4. The Hon'ble Tribunal has already set aside the impugned order and directed refund within two months, with interest for any delay. The prolonged inaction at Corporate Office level is not only causing avoidable distress to the pensioner but also amounts to non-compliance of judicial directions.

5. We therefore earnestly request your personal intervention to ensure that the Personnel Section issues immediate instructions for refund of Rs.72,200/- to Shri R. Damodaran, and payment of interest at GPF rate, as mandated by the Tribunal. We shall be grateful for early action in this long-pending matter.
