Subject: Request for further intervention in Complaint No. 127376/2025 regarding procedurally invalid chargesheets issued to BSNL pensioners by Maharashtra Telecom Circle

Sir,

We hereby seek to draw your kind attention to the lack of progress in **Complaint No. 127376/2025**, arising from our representation dated **08.09.2025** addressed to the Chairman & Managing Director, BSNL, with a copy marked to your esteemed office. [Copy enclosed]

2. The said representation highlighted the **large number of chargesheets issued to BSNL pensioners after retirement** by Maharashtra Telecom Circle and CNTx-West Circle, Mumbai—chargesheets that are **procedurally invalid, legally unsustainable, and issued without jurisdiction**, in violation of DoP&PW OM dated **30.11.2021**, DoT letter dated **22.03.2022**, and Rule 61 of BSNL CDA Rules regarding post-retirement disciplinary proceedings.

3. We are grateful that the Central Vigilance Commission promptly **registered our representation as a complaint** and assigned **Complaint No. 127376/2025**, vide CVC's communication dated **08.10.2025**, and forwarded it to **CVO BSNL** for necessary action. Subsequently, the complaint status on the CVC portal indicated that **CVO BSNL had forwarded the matter to CGMT, Maharashtra Circle**, seeking a report. However, **since then, no further progress has been recorded**. Even the **reminder submitted through the CVC portal** has not resulted in any movement in the case.


4. Meanwhile, the affected BSNL pensioners who retired under BSNL VRS-2019 more than six years ago—continue to suffer due to **withholding of their legitimate pensionary benefits**, because of these **procedurally defective chargesheets issued years after retirement**.

5. In view of the prolonged inaction at the field level and the continuing hardship faced by the pensioners, we earnestly request the Commission to:

- (i) Kindly take up the matter once again with **CVO BSNL**,
- (ii) Ensure that a clear and time-bound report is obtained from **CGMT Maharashtra Circle**, and
- (iii) Direct appropriate action so that the **procedurally invalid chargesheets are withdrawn**, enabling the affected pensioners to receive their long-delayed retirement benefits.

6. We remain confident that the Commission will appreciate the seriousness of the issue, which involves not only violation of extant Government instructions but also avoidable harassment of senior citizens who have already completed their service without any pending disciplinary/judicial proceedings on the date of retirement.
