Sub: **Grievances of the absorbed BSNL IDA pensioners- Resolution adopted in the All India Conference of AIBSNLREA held at Varanasi on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 seeking intervention of Hon'ble Prime Minister of India in "Rectification of anomaly in grant of additional quantum of pension."**

Hon'ble Sir,

In the All India Conference of this Association convened at Varanasi on 24th and 25th March 2026, which witnessed participation by a substantial number of delegates from across the country, the delegates voiced acute dissatisfaction and concern over the continued non-redressal of pensioners' grievances, particularly those affecting BSNL IDA pensioners. The Conference also recorded its serious disquiet over the consistent disregard by the Department of Telecommunications and BSNL of the binding instructions issued by the Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare on several matters.

2. In view of the above, the Conference unanimously resolved to approach the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India for timely intervention, as it was felt that the concerned Ministries and Departments have, in numerous cases, been disposing of grievances with routine and unrelated replies instead of addressing the substantive issues involved. The Conference adopted a total of 13 Resolutions covering various matters. We now respectfully submit Resolution No. 6 for your kind consideration, which relates to the Department of Health and Family Welfare and concerns the " **Rectification of anomaly in grant of additional quantum of pension**", as detailed in the enclosed resolution, with a request to advise DoP&T and DoP&PW to resolve the issue expeditiously.

**ACTION REQUIRED BY DoP&T and DoP&PW**

**06. RESOLUTION NO. AIBSNLREA/AIC-VARANASI/06**

**RECTIFICATION OF ANOMALY IN GRANT OF ADDITIONAL QUANTUM OF PENSION:** The All India Conference of AIBSNLREA held at Varanasi on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> March 2026 notes the inequity faced by pensioners born on the first day of a month, who retire a month earlier but are denied the additional quantum of pension from the month in which they actually complete the age of eligibility. A person born on the 1st of a month retires a full month earlier than others born later in the same month. When it comes to the additional quantum of pension, both individuals are allowed the benefit on the first day of the same month. The person born on the 1st of a month is disadvantaged twice - first by retiring a month earlier, and second by not receiving the additional pension a month earlier. **This Conference urges the Government to amend the rules so that pensioners born on the 1st of a month receive the additional quantum from the month in which they complete the prescribed age, thereby removing the existing inconsistency and ensuring equal treatment.**
