### PENSION PARITY AT THE CROSSROADS – A LOOMING CRISIS DEEPENS

In March 2025, the parliament passed the Finance Bill, 2025, with 'Validation of CCS (Pension) Rules' embedded in it under Part IV. This legislation has proviso that *"The Central Government may from time to time lay down such norms, principles and method in regard to acceptance of the recommendations of the Central Pay Commissions, including, among other things, distinction among pensioners that may arise out of the acceptance of such recommendation and in particular pension claims and liabilities"*, and *"this part shall come into force and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1972"*, thereby giving the Government the authority to deal with past cases too.

The legislation clarifies that *"the Central Government has the authority and shall always be deemed to have had the authority, to classify its pensioners and may create or maintain distinction amongst pensioners as deemed expedient for implementing the recommendations of the Central Pay Commissions under the Part."* It further clarifies that *"the date of retirement of pensioners shall be the basis of distinctions and for classification in regard to pension entitlement."*

Pensioners throughout the country reacted with immediate and widespread protests against the validation legislation, as it aims to eliminate the established parity in pensions between those who retired earlier and those retiring in revised pay scales. This

parity was first introduced by the V CPC and then continued by the VI CPC and VII CPC by way of revising the pension of the past pensioners from the date of implementation of the pay revision as per recommendation of respective CPC and with the same fitment benefit. On the same principle, BSNL absorbed pensioners who retired prior to 1.1.2007 also demanded and got the parity following implementation of pay revision of BSNL employees as per the recommendations of Second PRC with their pension revised w.e.f. 1.1.2007 and with the same fitment benefit of 30%.

Recognizing the potential impact of the validation legislation on BSNL absorbed pensioners, AIBSNLREA implemented a successful Email Campaign with members sending emails to Prime Minister and the Finance Minister requesting to withdraw the legislation. Meanwhile, various Central Government pensioner associations responded with their own forms of protest and agitation, each choosing actions that aligned with their perspectives and capabilities.

Though the Government claimed in the legislation that *"it has become necessary to deal with the interpretation of the Courts and to address the issue relating to pensioners of the Central Government, and expedient to retain the relevance of having such distinction by a validation legislation, dealing with the pension rules and instructions issued from*

*time to time in this regard*”, we had warned through our Editorial of Ejournal, April 2025 that the Validation legislation embedded in the Finance Act 2025 was no mere technicality.

**W**e had expressed our concern that *“the Government is not unwise to choose a cannon to kill a fly. Armed with the ‘authority to classify the pensioners based on the date of retirement’ the Government may leave out pension revision from the terms of reference of VIII CPC. Even if included, the VIII CPC may stop short of recommending pension revision, citing the ‘authority to classify’”*.

**O**ur apprehensions have come true. Terms of Reference for VIII CPC notified by the Government, is silent about revision of pension of past pensioners, unlike the Terms of Reference of VI and VII CPCs. While the TOR of VI CPC directed examining *“the principles which should govern pension, DCRG, family pension and other terminal benefits having financial implications to the present and former Central Government employees”*, VII CPC had a specific TOR - *“To examine the principles which should govern the structure of pension and other retirement benefits, including revision of pension in the case of employees who have retired prior to the date of effect of these recommendations.”*

**C**entral Government pensioners feel both frustrated and disappointed by the Terms of Reference for the Eighth CPC, which instructs the Commission to make recommendations *“keeping in view the unfunded cost of the non-contributory pension scheme”*—a veiled reference to the Old Pension Scheme.

**R**equests from various Central Government Pensioners’ organisations and umbrella bodies for an amendment to the TOR by including ‘Pension Revision’ in the

Terms of Reference has not yielded any result so far. On the contrary, to a pointed question in the Parliament as to *“whether revision of pension of Central Government employees is not proposed under eighth CPC, the reason therefor?”*, MoS (Finance) has replied that *“The Eighth CPC will make its recommendation on the various issues viz. Pay, Allowances, Pension etc of the Central Government employees”* again deliberately skipping the question of revision of pension.

**O**n its part, the DoT submitted a supplementary affidavit in a contempt petition in CAT Chandigarh Circuit Bench at Shimla filed by a group of BSNL pensioners, claiming authority to classify pensioners and to maintain distinctions based on the date of retirement, making the Government's intention clear. It is pertinent to note that DoP&PW has advised DoT *“to file appeal before the High Court against the Ld CAT order dated 23.01.2019 (alongwith order made in contempt cases) and defend the interest of Union of India”*. The case pertains to discrimination between pensioners retiring prior to 10.06.2013 and those retiring after that date.

**T**he petitions filed by S-30 Pensioners Association and FORIPSO (Forum of Retired IPS Officers), against the Validation legislation in Supreme Court are yet to be heard. Meanwhile a group of Central Government Pensioner Associations have also filed a petition in the Supreme Court challenging the legislation. Some of the BSNL Pensioners Associations are part of this effort.

**I**t is somewhat paradoxical that these associations, while arguing in the Delhi High Court for pension revision to be delinked from pay revision, are simultaneously challenging in the Supreme Court, the validation legislation through which the Government has effectively delinked pay revision and

pension revision with their 'authority' to classify the pensioners based on their date of retirement.

**T**he number of Central Government pensioners is very huge, and we, the BSNL pensioners, are a small fraction of that number. The Central Government pensioners' organisations themselves are divided on the matter, with a large section against pursuing legal route at this point in time, as they feel this may spoil the case of S-30 Pensioners. We can't be sure whether the Supreme Court will stand by its earlier verdict in Nakara case that " *this division which classified pensioners into two classes is not*

*based on any rational principle and if the rational principle is the one of dividing pensioners with a view to give something more to persons otherwise equally placed, it would be discriminatory*". And if pension revision is denied to Central Government pensioners, BSNL pensioners will have no grounds to claim it, even if and when BSNL employees' pay scales are revised.

**A**s parity in pension between past and future pensioners forms the foundation for pension revision, any move by the Government to classify pensioners and deny this parity would put the prospect of pension revision in peril. ☹



## Important Developments of the Month

- ✚ A virtual review meeting of DoP&PW with Pensioner Associations, Chaired by Secretary (Pension) was held on 14.11.2025. After introductory remarks by Chairman, all the registered associations were called individually to share their views. On behalf of AIBSNLREA, General Secretary praised the excellent effort by DoP&PW and conveyed that our Branches are taking part in the DLC camps organised by DoT, although BSNL pensioners submit their LC in different months throughout the year. He said that our members are regularly guided over using face authentication and now more than 80% of the members submit DLC on their own. Secretary (Pension) informed the participants that 1 crore pensioners across the country have already submitted their life certificates and requested the Pensioner Associations to continue their efforts so as to meet the target of 2 crore pensioners. Joint Secretary (Pension) said the campaign was progressing well and requested all to chalk out day-wise plan to ensure maximum submission of DLC. The Chairman closed the meeting after thanking the participants.
- ✚ AIBSNLREA AGS Shri V.P.Arya visited BSNL CO on 06.11.2025 and discussed pending issues with available officers. In respect of Shri M.N.Chavda, fresh VC has been received and work for holding review DPC has been initiated. On implementation of Chennai CAT orders on stepping up of pay on par with juniors, the matter is still under examination, but a positive outcome is expected. Other issues could not be discussed due to non-availability of concerned officers.
- ✚ Government of India has issued Gazette notification formally constituting the Eighth Central Pay Commission and notifying its Terms of Reference. Confirming the worst fears of Central Government Pensioners following enactment of Validation Legislation

as part of Finance Act 2025, the Terms of Reference is silent about revision of pension of past pensioners, unlike the Terms of Reference of VI and VII CPCs. While the TOR of VI CPC directed examining "the principles which should govern pension, DCRG, family pension and other terminal benefits having financial implications to the present and former Central Government employees", VII CPC had a specific TOR - "To examine the principles which should govern the structure of pension and other retirement benefits, including revision of pension in the case of employees who have retired prior to the date of effect of these recommendations." ✚ The monthly virtual meeting of AIBSNLREA CHQ office bearers was held today under the Presidentship of Shri V.Chinnappiah, CHQ President. After introductory briefing by President, General Secretary spelt out the activities of the association during October 2025, developments that happened including wage agreement between BSNL unions and Management, AIBSNLREA's letter to Secretary DoT on relaxing affordability clause and rejecting the notion of 0% fitment, Revision of CGHS rates, disappointing order of DoT restricting the benefit of higher scales for organised accounts cadre only to the applicants, our letter to Prime Minister on the matter, delayed issue of IDA rate revision orders, DLC 4.0, decision of cabinet on Terms of Reference for VIII CPC, miscalculation of IDA rate and status of implementation of ITAT Chandigarh order. Both the President and the General Secretary were appreciative of the massive attendance, arrangements, emotion filled honouring of members, rapt attention by the participants during speeches till the end and the hard work behind it - talking about their experience on being present in the East Godavari Branch AGB meeting. All the Office bearers then narrated the activities in their area and expressed their view on the developments listed by the General Secretary. Shri B.S.Rajput OS (N) invited attention stating that non-members are invited to attend all Branch meetings in MP State and most of them become members in the meeting itself. After discussions it was decided that another letter should go to CBDT on the ITAT Chandigarh order and a brief on the matter explaining the status to the members be issued. Members will be guided towards submitting individual representation for condoning delay for filing revised ITR. Attention of DPE will be drawn towards the inaccuracy in its IDA orders. All the office bearers will co-ordinate with the State/Branch Secretaries to ensure that the VRS retired Executives who have not taken membership in any pensioner association are enrolled as members of AIBSNLREA. With Varanasi Branch already having offered to host next AIC, the office bearers will look out for more options so that the venue is finalised in the next meeting. The meeting lasted for more than two and a half hours and ended with the President expressing happiness over the cohesive functioning of the CHQ.
